# IN RE: ADDITIONAL APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE #2008-05

Julianne Havens, Starke County Prosecutor, requested \$1,250 for TNT Law Enforcement Training and \$22,108 out of Prosecutor's Child Support fund for insurance, PERF, and the county share of social security for an additional employee. Both requests are out of the County General Fund but the additional employee would be paid out of the Prosecutor's Incentive Fund. Douglas J Vessely moved to table these requests until the budget order comes in, seconded by Dan Awald, with five ayes.

Dan Awald moved to table the Circuit Court's request for \$2,500 for Psychiatric Services out of County General, until the budget order comes in. Jim VanVactor seconded the motion, and it passed with five ayes.

Jennifer Davis moved to approve the Surveyor's request for \$20,000 out of Surveyor's Corner Perpetual fund, seconded by Douglas J Vessely, with five ayes.

Douglas J Vessely moved to approve the Assessor's request for \$3,500 for extra help and \$270 for Social Security, both out of the Cumulative Reassessment Fund. Dan Awald seconded the motion, and it passed with five ayes.

Jennifer Davis moved to approve Davis Township's request for \$1,000 for additional salary certification out of Cumulative Reassessment, seconded by Jim VanVactor, with five ayes.

Jennifer Davis moved to approve \$1,750 for jail repairs out of Cumulative Capital Development, seconded by Douglas J Vessely, with five ayes.

## IN RE: HIGHWAY FINANCES

There was much discussion over the highway finances. The Auditor told them that her budget figures had not included it, but the state had included it, even though half of the Major Moves money had already been appropriated through an additional, months earlier, therefore being spent on everyday highway business.
