

Starke County Board of Health Meeting

May 24, 2018

Board Members Present: Deb Hansen, Dr. Lochner, Donna Bailey, Deb Windbigler, Brenda Stanojevic.

Also attending: Frank Lynch, Dr. Browne.

The meeting was called to order at 6:30 P.M.

A motion to approve last months minutes made by D.Bailey, 2nd D.Hansen.

New business: Staff reports were presented. Discussion was held regarding the septic installers in the county. The majority are IOPA certified. Discussed giving the installers until 6/2019 to become certified, as Starke is one of the last counties to require this. Motion: D.Bailey, 2nd B.Stanojevic.

F.Lynch said the budget is due June 15th. A part time clerical person will be hired to scan septic, birth, and death records. This is already a line item, so no approval is needed. Grovertown Post Office has a failing septic system, no permit is on file to know when it was installed. D.Hansen discussed new synthetic that is out containing rat poison. She also stated to watch for ticks and Lyme disease,

Old Business: Lomax Station wants to put in ten campsites. Still awaiting word from State. The cooler at Heartland Market is still an issue. USA Café now has a permit.

Still no response from Family Dollar regarding a food permit.
