- Pledge of Allegiance

- Approval of the minutes of the August 12, 2019 meeting: Ms. Cultice made a motion to approve the minutes as written, seconded by Mr. Cavender. Motion carried (7-0)

    - Mr. Crase stated that there have been more infractions on the property since this all began.
    - Mr. Bedrock stated that we should have all of the violations in order for when we go to court.
  - Mr. Cavender asked what was being done with the trailer that is setting on the corner of US 35 & Toto Rd, also stating something needs to be done.
    - Mr. Chaffins explained that we made a motion (2) two months ago to have Mr. Campagna and Mr. Coffin move it and it is still setting there.
