# NORTH JUDSON SAN PIERRE APPROPRIATION REDUCTION

Auditor Oesterreich explained that they are here today to talk about an appropriation reduction in the amount of \$468,814.00 for North Judson San Pierre Schools. After much discussion with all members present as well as Attorney Lucas the Board has requested that the following sentence within the resolution be changed as follows:

Prior to change – Whereas, the North Judson-San Pierre School Corporation has advertised a budget in excess of moneys available.

Changed to - Whereas, the North Judson-San Pierre School Corporation has advertised a budget in excess of moneys needed.

Councilman Hazelton made a motion to adopt the appropriations reduction resolution with the above modified change. Councilwoman Gudeman seconded the motion and the motion was approved with all ayes.

### **CLERK – ABSENTEE BOARD WORKER PAY**
