STARKE COUNTY AIRPORT AUTHORITY

Councilman Bailey made a motion to approve the 2020 Starke County Airport Authority budget in the total amount of \$1,473,693. Councilman White seconded the motion and the motion passed with all ayes.

KOONTZ LAKE CONSERVANCY DISTRICT

Councilwoman Gudeman made a motion to approve the 2020 Koontz Lake Conservancy District budget in the total amount of \$210,205. Councilman Sims seconded the motion and the motion passed with all ayes.
