# Starke County Highway Department Monthly Report – December 3rd , 2018

## ROADS

**Winter plowing** -- We had five snow/ice events in November, slightly more than average. It was good on the job training for our newest drivers. There was enough to get a real feel of how it is to plow snow in a large dump truck but was not enough to be overwhelming. We continue to haul in material for next years road improvements when the weather allows it.

**Road Assessments -** We have begun our road assessments and are beginning to form our road improvement list for next summer. We have received a request to convert a gravel road to a paved road (150E from 400S to 500S). We are doing as assessment based on traffic, accident, and resident data and funding availability.

**Community Crossings Grant Projects** -Two of our Community Crossings grant applications were approved by INDOT. A resurfacing on CR25N from 600E to SR23 and an intersection improvement on CR210 at Bass Lake. Both projects will be bid out in January.

### REPLACEMENTS/REHABS

The Bridge 154 replacement will begin soon.

**Bridge Maintenance-** We have repaired the guard rail at four more bridges this month. We have also fixed the approaches at bridge #38 on CR800E, just south of CR500N and we are in the process of repairing the approaches at bridge #52 on 850S just east of CR800E
