VHJ/COD OF TERRITORIAL ENGR FOUND A HEADLESS TRACK BOLT WITH METAL CAP OVER A BROKEN HARRISON MONUMENT 8" BELOW GRADE.

THE HARRISON MONUMENT WAS REFERENCED BY CETA ON SEPTEMBER 21, 1977 OVER A 9" STONE.

VHJ/COD REPLACED THE BOLT WITH A 3/4" GALV PIPE IN A MORTAR BASE OVER THE BROKEN HARRISON.

ALSO, TWO RR SPIKES 2'± NORTH, THREE RR SPIKES 2'± EAST, AND ONE RR SPIKE ADJACENT TO THE TRACK BOLT WERE FOUND AND SUBSEQUENTLY REMOVED.

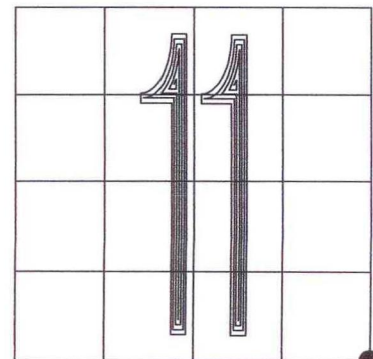
