### CORNER DISCOVERY:

DIMENSIONS FROM C.E. PAUL'S 1932 COUNTY LINE SURVEY WERE USED TO PINPOINT LOCATION.

ON FEBRUARY 8, 2005, DPS/VHJ/COD OF TERRITORIAL ENGR, LLC, DUG HOLE 2' X 3' X 1.2' DEEP AND FOUND A WOODEN STAKE WITH CHISEL POINT BENT OVER WITH ONE SQUARE FOOT OF CONCRETE OR MORTAR 1'± EAST OF STAKE AND 1.5'± BELOW GRADE.

FENCE WIRE WAS FOUND RUNNING TO THE MORTAR FROM THE NORTH.

A 5/8" ROD WAS SET 1" BELOW GRADE AT BASE OF THE DISCOVERED STAKE.

THE 5/8" ROD WAS FOUND BENT. A RAIL BOLT WAS SET AT LOCATION.

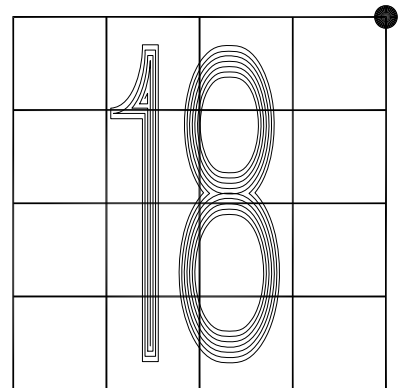
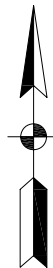
