Starke County Highway Department Monthly Report July 2014

Summarv

MOWING – The County mowing program is progressing as planned. We are beginning our fourth cycle of mowing. We currently have seven part-time mowers on staff. This allows us to keep a full complement of mowers on the road five days a week despite the part time hour limitations.

ROAD IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM – During June we used our pug mill to create 6170 tons of asphalt. We also produce 445 tons of patching material. Our cost was \$29.78 per ton. This represents a great savings over our costs of hauling in patch material from Central Paving at \$95.00 a ton (cost of the patch, diesel fuel to haul, and the driver's time). Our annual patch material costs will decrease from approximately \$105,000 a year to \$33,000 a year for a savings of \$72,000 per year. Based on initial reports from our drivers the patch material we have made is superior to that created by Central Paving. Ricky Fisher, our pug mill operator, deserves and has received a letter of commendation for his file as a result of his excellent work in creating the pug and patch. We will use the pug we made to do our paving and wedging. This will begin in two weeks after we have completed one round of chip seal in Koontz Lake and in other areas in the northeast corner of the County. We are on track to complete our planned 145 miles of road improvements
