We are currently working on the RFP for our next round of bridge inspections. It will be sent out by INDOT later this month. We are currently using USI consultants for our inspections. Our inspections fees will be much less this time because we have far fewer deficient bridges. In fact, by the end of this contract we should have no deficient bridges which means we will not have to pay for any supplemental inspections

CURRENT ROAD IMPROVEMENTS In August we were hampered a bit by the weather but we did manage to complete most of our scheduled cold mix asphalt paving. We completed over 19 miles of gravel roads this month. In September, we had planned on hot mixing 300E from SR8 to the Knox industrial park but that is now delayed because of the Community Crossings delay. Mowing is has been scaled back from six to two mowers. The remaining two will double mow the entire County this month.
