EMT – Basic

General Description: Responds to emergency and non-emergency requests, provides basic life support (BLS) as needed and transports sick or injured persons to the appropriate medical facility.

Essential Function:

- The Performance of all required Basic skills with confidence and accuracy while requiring minimum supervision
- The execution of the proper patient care actions for any given patient situation in accordance with local protocols and Starke County E.M.S. policies and procedures
- Maintenance of all continuing Education requirements to fulfill your certification and the Starke County EMS guidelines
- Demonstration of Cautions, courteous, efficient, and defensive driving while in Starke County EMS vehicles
- Proficiency in the use of, and knowledge of proper operations of all BLS equipment
- Demonstrate the ability to direct the actions of others who may have lesser training in a positive manner. Along with this, applicant must have the ability to direct and control the EMS aspect of any scene (within our capabilities) while maintaining stability and professionalism.

Physical Requirements:

- Performs duties in a standard office environment and in the field, including sitting/walking at will, driving, close vision and hearing sounds/communication.
- Must be able to lift weights as the job requires at any given time.

Experience/Education/Qualifications Requirements:

- High School Diploma or GED
- Applicant must be an Indiana State Certified EMT Basic.
- Thorough EMS knowledge and ability to make practical application of the Customary practices, procedures and financial regulations of the County, and to take authoritative action as situations demand.
- Knowledge of all department equipment and supplies, and ability to oversee proper care
- Ability to comply with all employer and department policies and work rules, including but not limited to, attendance, safety, drug-free workplace, and personal conduct
- Ability to understand, memorize, retain and carry out written or oral instructions and present findings in oral or written form.
- Ability to occasionally work extended, evening, and or weekend hours
- Must be Physically able to perform any duties as assigned by Starke County EMS
- Possession of a valid Indiana driver's license and demonstrate safe driving record
- Must have Current CPR certification
