A PRELIMINARY RESOLUTION FOR THE ESTABLISHMENT OF AN ECONOMIC REVITALIZATION AREA FOR THE STARKE CENTRAL PROJECT

Resolution No. of 2024

WHEREAS, Ind. Code § 6-1.1-12.1, *et seq*. empowers the County Council of Starke County, Indiana (the "Council") to designate an Economic Revitalization Area by following a procedure involving the adoption of a preliminary resolution, provision for public notice, conducting a public hearing, and adoption of a final confirmatory resolution, or a modified version thereof; and

WHEREAS, Starke Central Project, LLC ("Developer") has requested that certain properties all located entirely within Starke County, Indiana for the Starke Central Project described in the attached **Exhibit A**, attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference, and depicted on the maps in **Exhibit B**, also attached hereto and incorporated herein, be designated as an Economic Revitalization Area for the purpose of achieving a deduction to assessed valuation (property-tax abatement) in connection with redevelopment activity occurring on the affected properties; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of Starke County, Indiana (the "Board of Commissioners"), is responsible for the performance of various functions for Starke County, Indiana. The Board of Commissioners has been presented with and reviewed Developer's request and evidence and recommends to the Council that it adopt this Preliminary Resolution to designate the Starke Central Project properties as an Economic Revitalization Area; and

WHEREAS, Developer submitted substantial evidence to the Council in support of Developer's requested designation of the properties as Economic Revitalization Area, which has been duly considered by the Council;

WHEREAS, the Council believes that Developer has satisfied the standards set forth within the Indiana Code and that it is in the best interests of the citizens of Starke County to designate the Starke Central Project properties as an Economic Revitalization Area.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT:

- 1. The Council now adopts and approves this Preliminary Resolution and hereby establishes the affected parcels as an Economic Revitalization Area for a period of Forty (40) years, subject to the adoption of a confirmatory resolution.
- 2. The Economic Revitalization Area allows abatement of property taxes attributable to redevelopment or rehabilitation activities and the installation of new manufacturing equipment, all as defined in Ind. Code § 6-1.1-12.1-1 and permitted under Ind. Code §§ 6-1.1-12.1-3 and 6-1.1-12-4.5.

- 3. Such redevelopment or rehabilitation activities and such manufacturing equipment as described in <u>Section 2</u> herein are limited strictly to investments made for the purpose of generating electricity from solar energy for the public grid and to activities and equipment in direct support of such efforts, or for other purposes related thereto and fully compliant with the Starke County Solar Energy Ordinance No. 2022-017 and with the Starke County zoning code, maps and exhibits as may be amended from time to time, and any actions taken to enforce and interpret such applicable ordinances and zoning.
- 4. A copy of this Preliminary Resolution shall be filed with the Starke County Assessor.
- 5. A copy of this Preliminary Resolution and a description of the deduction to assessed valuation to be requested by the Developer shall be provided to each affected taxing unit.
- 6. The Council hereby fixes 6:00 p.m. (CST) on November 19, 2024, at the Nancy J. Dembowsky Community Center, located at 55 E. Lake St., Knox, IN 46534, as the time, date, and location for a public hearing for receiving any remonstrance and objections from interested persons prior to the adoption of a final confirmatory resolution, designating the affected Starke County parcels as an Economic Revitalization Area and considering any deduction to assessed valuation requested by the Developer.
